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Imperial County Area Agency on Aging Now Accepting Applications for the open position of Service Provider on the Area Agency on Aging Advisory Council

The Imperial County Area Agency on Aging (ICAAA) announced that it is accepting applications for the Service Provider Member position, which is part of the Advisory Council. Currently, one (1) vacant Service Provider position is available. This member must be a representative of service providers to the aging, excluding AAA contractors, as selected by the Council; therefore, such a person could represent any of the following: transportation, health care, pharmaceutical, housing, financial benefits.

The Imperial County Area Agency on Aging Advisory Council serves to advise the ICAAA regarding issues important to Imperial County seniors and their caregivers. The Advisory Council members support the ICAAA with the following purposes: hold annual public hearings, needs assessments, recommendations, program monitoring, and advocacy.

The composition of the Advisory Council is prescribed in the laws and regulations of the Older Americans Act (federal), as amended, and the Older Californians Act (state). All members are responsible to participate, as fully as possible, in all activities of the Council, including the development, revision, and approval of the Area Plan on Aging. Each member is required to be present, to serve on at least one committee, and to attend scheduled meetings of the Advisory Council.
