Now Accepting Applications for the open positions

on the Area Agency on Aging Advisory Council

The Imperial County Area Agency on Aging (ICAAA) announced that it is accepting applications for the Senior Advocate Member position and the Law Enforcement Member position, which is part of the Advisory Council. Currently the ICAAAA has one (1) vacant Senior Advocate position and one (1) vacant Law Enforcement position available. Individuals seeking appointment to the Senior Advocate Member position, as selected by the Advisory Council, such a person, could represent any of the following: family member of frail elderly, program participant, veteran or veteran representative, and/or community volunteer. Individuals seeking appointment to the Law Enforcement Member position, as selected by the Council, such a person, active or retired, could be associated with police, sheriff, federal agent, or the justice system.

The Imperial County Area Agency on Aging Advisory Council serves to advise the ICAAAA regarding issues important to Imperial County seniors and their caregivers. The Advisory Council members support the ICAAAA with the following purposes: annual public hearings, needs assessments, recommendations, program monitoring, and advocacy.

The composition of the Advisory Council is prescribed in the laws and regulations of the Older Americans Act (federal), as amended, and the Older Californians Act (state). All members are responsible to participate, as fully as possible, in all activities of the Council, including the development, revision, and approval of the Area Plan on Aging. Each member is required to be present, to serve on at least one committee, and to attend scheduled meetings of the Advisory Council.

Applications are due by August 14, 2020, and elections are to be conducted during the regularly scheduled Advisory Council Meeting on September 17, 2020, at 9:00 a.m.
