Imperial County Area Agency on Aging is Now Accepting Applications – At-large Advisory Council Members

The Imperial County Area Agency on Aging (ICAAA) announced that it is accepting applications for two (2) at-large member positions [one recommended to represent the Health Insurance Counseling and Advocacy Program (HICAP)] on their Advisory Council.

The Imperial County Area Agency on Aging Advisory Council serves to advise the ICAAA regarding issues important to Imperial County seniors and their caregivers. The Advisory Council members support the ICAAA with the following purposes: annual public hearings, needs assessments, recommendations, program monitoring, and advocacy.

The composition of the Advisory Council is prescribed in the laws and regulations of the Older Americans Act (Federal), as amended, and the Older Californians Act (State). All members are responsible to participate, as fully as possible, in all activities of the Council, including the development, revision, and approval of the Area Plan on Aging. Each member is required to be present, to serve on at least one committee, and attend scheduled meetings of the Advisory Council.
